Fitting & Showing, Saddle Seat pattern, Equitation over Fences, gymkhana and any riding class with a pattern will be in back number order.

Rail classes with a pattern-riders will be called in in back number order, perform their pattern, line up in the ring and then ride one way on the rail – once the rider enters the ring, they must remain in the ring until the judge excuses them. Leaving the ring prior to completion of the class will result in the rider being disqualified.

Classes with 20 or more riders: all riders will do the pattern – 12 riders will be called back in.

Classes with 19 or less riders: all riders will do the pattern and return for rail work.

Meet 1 – if a class has 20 or more riders, the pattern will be posted by 8:30 am.
